<u>Competition Program</u>: Entrants of Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Elementary levels are required to present more than one piece, representing at least two stylistic periods. No arranged piano pieces may be played. Memorization is required. Student compositions will be allowed only if the student performs two other contrasting pieces from the standard published repertoire within the allotted performance time. **Entrants must not repeat repertoire from prior CNYAMT years' competitions.**

- All auditions are CLOSED to teachers. Parents may attend the audition.
- No electronic equipment will be allowed.
- All Place Winners of the Senior, Intermediate, Junior and Elementary Competitions commit themselves to perform on the winner's recital Sunday, March 18, 2018 which will take place starting at 2:00 PM at Park Central Presbyterian Church.
- First Place Winners of the Senior, Intermediate, Junior, and Elementary Competitions (High Honors) will play their complete program provided it does not exceed the maximum playing time. All other winners will be allowed a maximum of playing time as follows: 7 Minutes, 6 minutes, 5 minutes, and 4 minutes respectively.
- Entrants, please submit together with your application and entry fee the following:
 ONE COPY of a short narrative-style biography of 75 words with name, parents' name, address, school, grade in school, music teacher, music awards, organizations of which entrant is a member, hobbies, any other points of interest. Include competition program at the end of the paragraph.

NOTE:

Entrants, you will NOT be called for your biography if you forget to include it in your application.

FOR PARENTS:

- We attest that the information given on this application is accurate.
