

## Uploading Videos onto YouTube

### **From your computer:**

**1. *Log into YouTube or create a free account.***

**2. *Uploading***

Click the “Camera+” icon on the top-right corner to upload a new video.

**3. *Title***

The title of each video will consist of the assigned competition number, which will be provided through email after the division chairperson receives your application, followed by the title of the selection and the name of the composer. For example:

“E06 - Minuet on G Major, BWV Anh 114 – Bach”

**4. *Settings***

- A. Under the section “Is this video made for kids?” select “No, it’s not made for kids.”
- B. Click “Next” to go to Video Elements and then click “Next” again to go to Visibility.
- C. Select “Unlisted” under the Visibility section and copy the video link to include in your application.

**5. *Saving***

Click “Save”. Your video may take a while to process if it is a large, high-definition file.

**From your phone:**

**1. *Log into YouTube or create a free account.***

**2. *Uploading***

- A. Click “+” icon on the bottom of the screen to upload a new video.
- B. After choosing a video from your phone, you will be automatically directed to the next step.
- C. On the next page, click “Next” in the upper right.

**3. *Settings***

- A. Create a title.

The title of each video will consist of the assigned competition number, which will be provided through email after the division chairperson receives your application, followed by the title of the selection and the name of the composer. For example:

“E06 - Minuet on G Major, BWV Anh 114 – Bach”

- B. Select “Unlisted” and then click “Next”.
- C. Select “No, it’s not made for kids”.
- D. Click “Upload”.

**4. *Share link***

After uploading successfully, go to “Library” and click the video to obtain the video link to include in your application.
