- Memorization is recommended, but not required.
- All Winners and Honorable Mention recipients commit themselves to performing on the winner's recital, Sunday, May 4, 2020 at 1:30 PM at Park Central Presbyterian Church.
- Monetary awards will be given, depending upon enrollment, up to a maximum of three places per division.
- Information about competition day details and final results will be given to teachers only, by e-mail or telephone.
- Prior division winners will be required to move up to the next division regardless of age.
- Rules set forth on this page will be strictly enforced.
