Video Submission Guidelines

Recording

Videos can be made at home by the student, in the teacher's studio or in a performance hall. The quality of instrument, location, or quality of video will not be a factor in judging.

- The performance video will show a profile camera view that includes both hands and feet of the contestant playing their competition program.
- Each selection must be shown in one take, with no editing.
- Position the camera so that the performer's right-hand profile from head to toe is visible, with a clear view of the entire keyboard and pedals.
- The entrant must submitone YouTube video for each selection. Please state the title of the selection before playing.

YouTube Video Upload

- Upload recordings on YouTube to a single playlist with each piece as a separate video.
- The title of each video will consist of the assigned competition number, which will be provided through email after the division chairperson receives your application, followed by the title of the selection and the name of the composer. For example:

"E06 - Minuet on G Major, BWV Anh 114 - Bach"

• Configure the videos "unlisted" so it's viewable to anyone with the link but not accessible to the public.

[Important Note] This is an anonymous competition. Do NOT state your name in the video or have it included in the YouTube video in any way. Videos that include identifying this information will be disqualified.

Email to the Division Chair

- The subject of the email should include the entrant's name and the assigned number.
- In the body of the email, include the **Repertoire List** and the **YouTube video links** associated with each selection.
